Notes:
*This plan is recommended for runners new to the Half Marathon distance.
*Begin each Run Session with a 5 minute walk, gradually increasing your pace.
*Finish each Run Session with a 5 minute easy walk.
*All runs should be done at Aerobic Z1 (rate of perceived exertion of 4-6 on a scale of 10) or comfortable conversation pace, and may be done as a continuous run or as run/walk intervals (see suggested format below).
*Include two strength training days per week (Monday and Friday).
*It is recommended that you stretch after each run.
*Include one complete rest day per week (Wednesday).
*Optional Run/Walk Progression Program (Weeks 1-8)
Week 1-1 minute run/1 minute walk
Week 2-2 minute run/1 minute walk
Week 3-3 minute run/1 minute walk
Week 4-3 minute run/1 minute walk
Week 5-4:00 minute run/1 minute walk
Week 6-4:15 minute run/45 second walk
Week 7- 4:30 minute run/30 second walk
Week 8 - continuous run (or run/walk interval of your choice)
